



British LED have based energy calculations and installation quotation, on information made available during our initial site survey.

This quote for works, is based on several installation and project assumptions:

#### ***Prior to Installation***

- British LED have made no allowance to alter circuitry or switching (Unless specified)
- British LED assume that existing wiring meets with current wiring regulation standards BS7671 – If for any reason it does not, we will notify the client, with a costed option to upgrade to current standards (Variation).
- Please advise British LED if a formal set of RAMS needs to be submitted (Risk Assessment & Method Statement) with any lead time requirements, prior to date of installation
- The client should advise if a detailed Mobilisation Plan needs to be provided, prior to date planned installation

#### ***Installation***

- British LED will require a designated and secure area of storage, for installation projects which last more than one day
- We assume we will be given free and clear access to all areas when necessary to enable us to undertake our works in an efficient manner. We understand that there are operational needs to the client, if required British LED will produce a phased programme which best fits the clients needs
- British LED have allowed to disconnect, remove and cart away all redundant luminaires that are being replaced, including the safe and rightful disposal of lamps from these.
- Waste will either be disposed of onsite via skips, or shipped back to British LED facility for recycling, depending on size of installation.

#### ***Completion of works***

- On completion of works, where wiring has been altered, we will carry out thorough electrical checks and test to all circuits that are planned to be reused. We have assumed that these, together with switchgear and circuit protection will be found suitable and therefore have made no allowance to alter, add to or rewire.
- Should the client require 'AS BUILT' drawings, LUX simulations, and Lighting Plans – we assume that DWG building files are made available, so that our design engineers can operate within accurate building plans. This service will be chargeable, unless otherwise stated within quote.
- Extensive Installation Projects, which may require frequent site visits, should be notified to British LED prior to issue of Purchase Order
- Should the client require full sets of Installation Certification, Emergency Lighting Installation Certification, O&M manuals and any other certification – this will be chargeable, based on time required for electrical engineer to complete.

#### **Payment Terms**

- For project works, involving design, product supply and/or installation, British LED require a 50% deposit prior to commencement of works, with 50% balance payment due on completion.
